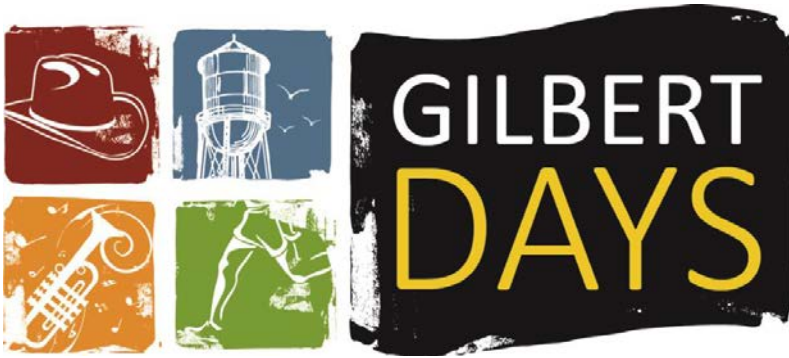
Homeowners Must Plant Winter Grass

As we draw nearer to Fall, we wanted to remind homeowners of the community rule regarding winter lawn. The Higley Groves Homeowners' Association requires homeowners to overseed their front yards during the winter months.

The Landscape and Design Guidelines read: *"Turf: All turf shall be kept green. During the winter months of November through January homeowners shall overseed with winter rye grass to maintain a green lawn. Painting of lawns green or any shade of green is prohibited."*
