Summer means kids are out playing - please slow down on our streets

Summer in our community means families are out enjoying the amenities in the neighborhood. When driving along our streets, please keep an eye out for kids and pets, following all posted speed limits for safety.

According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, in 2012, more than one in every five children between the ages of 5 and

15 who were killed in traffic crashes were pedestrians. Additionally, most pedestrian deaths occurred in urban areas, non-intersection locations, and at night.

Keeping pedestrians safe in our community means drivers should slow down and pedestrians should be more visible, crossing at intersections and wearing light-reflective clothing.



Safety tips for keeping safe while cooling off in the pool

In 2011, 19 children drowned in Maricopa County, according to the Arizona Child Fatality Review Program. These preventable deaths are devastating for all involved. To keep your kids safe around water, here are some pool safety tips from the Drowning Prevention Coalition of Arizona:

Block

Make sure your pool and/or spa has an effective barrier, such as a fence to help guard against unauthorized access.

Your pool or spa should have a barrier regardless of whether they are covered.

Door and windows leading to the pool areas should be locked.

Fence gates should have self-closing, self-latching mechanisms. Latches need to be out of reach of young children.

Watch

Never leave your child unattend-

ed in or near a swimming pool, hot tub, spa, not even for a second.

Keep toys, tricycles, and other children's play things away from the pool or spa.

Don't consider your children to be "drownproof" because they have taken swimming lessons.

Don't allow barriers, such as fences or walls, give you a false sense of security regarding your child's safety. There is no substitute for adult supervision.

Learn

Learn how to administer CPR, mouth-to-mouth resuscitation, and other lifesaving techniques. To administer CPR correctly you must be properly trained.

Know how to contact your local emergency medical services. Install a phone or keep a cordless phone in the pool or spa area. Post the emergency number in an easy to see place.

Learn to swim and teach age appropriate children to swim.

Bees are active during summer - keep safe with these tips

Bees often swarm in the summer, when plants are blooming and flowering. If you see a large number of bees in or around irrigation boxes, please call the management company, Renaissance Community Partners, at 480-813-6788. Here are some tips to keep safe around bees and hives.

1. Don't wear perfumes or colognes.

2. Avoid wearing brightly colored clothing, especially floral prints.

3. Be careful what you eat outdoors.
